

Journaling formats: triple-entry

Triple-entry journal format

A triple-entry journal format is similar to the double-entry, but has one more column. Its purpose is to invite colleagues into the dialogue you are having with a written text. After you complete your responses (columns one and two), exchange journals with someone else in your learning community. Your colleague will respond to your two columns, and you in turn respond to theirs. This process develops a supportive environment for professional dialogue and encourages colleagues to construct new understandings together.
